

Directions

Take your pink candy discs and put in a microwave safe bowl.

<u>UDALL CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES</u> <u>December 13th, 2023</u>

The Udall City Council met for the City Council Meeting on Wednesday December 13th, 2023, at 6:30pm at the Udall City Building Council Room. Matt McAllister, Mayor, called the meeting to order. Council members present were Mitch Kratochvil, Randy Hoffman, Dan Rutschman, Jim Caywood and David Franz. Quorum established. Also, present were Andrew Marino, Jennifer Mays, Erik King, Dennis White, Craig Hopkins, David Dill, Kendra Boyer, Shayla Boyer, Dave Williams, Shonda Green and Leonard Mumford.

Modification to Agenda - None

MOTION by **Hoffman** to accept the consent agenda as presented. SECONDED by **Caywood. McAllister** called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried.

Business from the floor – Shonda Green – Thanked the Council for the Christmas Evening and shared all the good feedback she'd received. She also stated that any suggestions for next year would be appreciated. The Council thanked her, and Mrs. Green left the meeting.

Consent Agenda - MOTION by Caywood to accept the consent agenda as presented. SECONDED by Hoffman.

McAllister called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried.

OLD BUSINESS

Stewart Addition – Smith and Oakes are putting the contract out to bid including both concrete and asphalt. He will talk to the bidders. Drawing discussion elevations and culverts. Leonard Mumford discussed buyers for lots. Temporary drive discussed. Dave Williams discussion.

MOTION by **Kratochvil** to enter Executive Session at 7:22pm to discuss legal to include the city attorney and ending at 7:37pm. SECONDED by **Hoffman. McAllister** called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried.

7:35pm - McAllister called the meeting back to order. No binding action taken.

Dave Williams discussion continues.

MOTION by **Franz** to no payment by D&T's Hauling for sewer repair at the community building. SECONDED by **Caywood. McAllister** called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried.

MOTION by Caywood to approve paying D&T's Hauling their final payment for the current work being done on the Stewart Addition. SECONDED by Franz. McAllister called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried.

MOTION by Rutschman to approve extending Mumford Contracting's Contract to October 1st, 2024.

SECONDED by Caywood. McAllister called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried.

NEW BUSINESS

David Dill – Re –Zone on Williams to commercial for storage facility. Erik King – Rezone to C2. Send letters to neighboring property (see drawing). The city attorney will research and give Erik advice. Then the Zoning board will have a hearing for Council in January.

2024 Price Increases – Waste Connections – is covered by Ordinance 691. City Attorneys hourly price increase to \$180/hour ok.

2023 Encumbered Cash to be rescinded - \$265.00 Pump Generator, \$672.00 Westfall Electric – MOTION by **Kratochvil** to rescind both approved purchases. SECONDED by **Hoffman. McAllister** called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried.

GAAP Resolution 209A – MOTION by Kratochvil to approve. SECONDED by Caywood. McAllister called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried Depository Resolution 350A – MOTION by Kratochvil to approve.

SECONDED by Hoffman. McAllister called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried.

CHARTER ORDINANCE 695 — Designating the city website as the official city newspaper — to be published in the Courier on Dec 19th and Dec 26th. Then sent to the Secretary of the State once it takes affect February 26th 2024. MOTION by Kratochvil to approve. SECONDED by Rutschman. McAllister called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried.

Ordinance 696 Amending and Raising Electrical Rates – MOTION by Hoffman to approve. Seconded by Franz. McAllister called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried.

Ordinance 673A Raising Court Costs - MOTION by Hoffman to approve. SECONDED by Kratochvil.

McAllister called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried.

Water Rates Proposal – Discussion of rate structure. MOTION by Hoffman to increase the minimum customer charge by \$1.00. The city attorney will draft the Ordinance. SECONDED BY Caywood. McAllister called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried.

2023 Notice of proposed property tax increase – Table to 2024

Sidewalk Project – Discussion – **Hoffman** heard from their attorney Thursday. Dollar General won't answer, he is waiting for them to respond to him.

116-118 E 1st – The city attorney said that this process is about 30 days out.

CMB Licenses – U Pump It and Udall Groceries – MOTION by Hoffman to approve both CMB licenses for 2024. SECONDED by Rutschman. McAllister called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION carried.

SR2013 Bond Payment due \$46,406.25 to be mailed at the beginning of January. - Discussion of which funds to transfer from to the B&I fund. MOTION by **Hoffman** to pull ½ from electric and ½ from sewer. To be refunded with the January Distribution from the County. SECONDED by **Caywood. McAllister** called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried.

County requesting airplane information – City Attorney emailed them.

Christmas Lunch for the council and employees – Discussion. Use the mayoral budget for December. Secret Santa - \$20 cap.




