Smoked Turkey-Bean Soup

From Udall T.O.P.S.
(Taking Off Pounds Sensibly)
6:30 pm each Thurs
Methodist Church
305 S Church

2 cups water
¾ cup chopped onion
¾ cup chopped carrots
¼ cup chopped celery
¼ tsp pepper
1 bay leaf
3 (15.8 oz) cans Great Northern beans, rinsed and drained
1 (14 oz) can fat-free, reduced-sodium chicken broth
1 (10 oz) whole smoked turkey leg
2 tsp white wine vinegar

Combine all ingredients except vinegar in a Dutch oven. Bring to a boil; reduce heat, and simmer, uncovered, 1 hour and 15 minutes. Stir in vinegar; discard bay leaf. Remove turkey leg from soup; discard skin. Remove meat from bone; discard bone. Shred meat into bite-sized pieces. Add turkey to soup.
YIELD: 6 servings (serving size: 1 cup)
