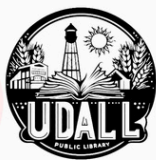
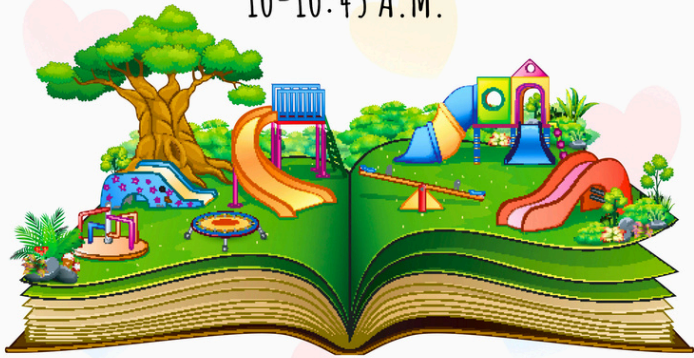

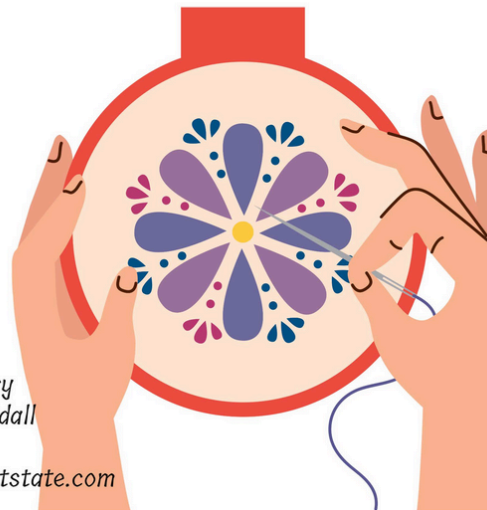

Council members present were Dan **Rutschman**, Randy **Hoffman**, Jim **Caywood**, Craig **Hopkins**, and David **Franz**. Quorum established. Also, present were Jennifer Mays, Erik King, Dennis White and Jack Wellman.

Meeting brought to order by **McAllister** at 6:30pm.

MOTION by **Franz** to accept the agenda as presented. SECONDED by **Caywood**. **McAllister** called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried.

- **MOTION** to table to February 2025 council meeting by Caywood. SECONDED by Franz. McAllister called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried.
- **Review of current pay scales**- Discussion
- Clerk, call all surrounding cities to get their pay scales.
- Utility Relocation phase, using Smith and Oakes?
- **MOTION** by **Hoffman** allowing the mayor to approve going into contract with whatever engineer Dennis decides on. SECONDED by **Caywood**. **McAllister** called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried.

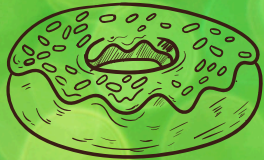
