### MODIFICATION OF THE AGENDA:

MOTION: by Smith, second by Adams, to approve the agenda as presented. All voted aye. Motion carried.

#### GENERAL DISCUSSION:

1. Santa Comes to Town, Saturday December 7. Santa visits from 12:00 – 3:00 p.m. Chili, Soups and Desserts will be available from 12:00 to 5:00 p.m. and accepting donations.

pineapples
(no sugar added)

1 tsp dark brown sugar

Mix cake mix (not prepared) with entire can of crushed pineapple (juice included). Add box of vanilla pudding (not prepared). Stir until blended. In bundt cake pan, place the 5 pineapple rings on the bottom with a cherry in the center of each ring. Sprinkle the tsp. of dark brown sugar over the 5 rings. Bake in 350° for 35 to 40 minutes or until done


## National Reading Day
