

Tell us what you noticed around town!






Leprechaun Maze

UDALL CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

January 14th, 2026

The Udall City Council met for the City Council Meeting on Wednesday, January 14, 2026, at 6:30pm in the Udall City Hall Council Room. Matt McAllister, Mayor, called the meeting to order. Council members were Dan Rutschman, Jim Caywood, Craig Hopkins, David Franz, and Mitch Kratochvil. Quorum was established. Also, present were Erik King, Travis Hart, Jennifer Mays, and Jack Wellman.

Meeting brought to order by McAllister at 6:30pm

Mitch Kratochvil sworn in by the City Clerk.

Pledge of Allegiance

Invocation – Jack Wellman

Modification to Agenda – None. MOTION by Caywood to accept the agenda as presented. SECONDED by Franz. McAllister called for a vote. All Ayes.

Business from the floor – NONE – Discussion of the videos submitted by the Daniels.

CONSENT AGENDA – MOTION to approve the Consent Agenda by Caywood. SECONDED by Hopkins. McAllister called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried.

OLD BUSINESS

406 N. Clark – Restart this process – left a message for the owner regarding licenses and permitting. Discussion regarding what the letter should contain to restart the process.

MOTION by Hopkins to approve the process. SECONDED by Caywood. McAllister called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried

NEW BUSINESS

T-Mobile Email – T-Mobile redline agreement. Tony with Maguire will be at the February council meeting to explain the Water Tower contracts and what is expected during this process. \$4000.00 rent/month - clerk will send redline to T-Mobile.

AT&T Contract – Reviewed by Maguire, the proposed design is acceptable.

MOTION by Kratochvil to accept the proposed design. SECONDED by Franz. McAllister called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried.

County Road Projects – Research grant opportunities and possible bond with intent to pay through possible sales tax increase of .5%. Can we asphalt and chip seal Main Street? – Travis will get a price and put a bid out on it.

Special Highway Fund Budget Increase? - No – Clerk – Find the last budget where streets were in the General Fund – Discussion


