MODIFICATION OF AGENDA:

MOTION: by Smith, second by Wilson, to approve the agenda as presented. All voted aye, motion carried.

CONSENT AGENDA:

He acknowledges they would both be excellent candidates for the position; however as he can only recommend one candidate it is Ethan Exley.

MOTION: by Adams, second by Smith, to approve Resolution #324. All voted aye, motion carried.

4. Resolution #325 Recognizing the 2020 Census and being a Census 2020 Partner

MOTION: by *Wilson*, second by *Smith*, approving Resolution #325. All voted aye, motion carried.


